



Whale Watch / Swim Trip

Season: July – October

Price: NZD\$180 (Observer) or NZD\$235 (Swim with Whales option)

Approximate Duration: 7 hours (8:30am to 3:30pm)

Grading: Easy/Moderate

Participants must possess an average level of fitness and the ability to walk stairs and climb a ladder to re-enter the boat after snorkelling.

Tour Description:

Learn about the Humpback Whale and other marine creatures whilst on an educational whale watching excursion within the Vava'u Archipelago! Join the naturalist guides aboard the custom-designed 8.5m vessel *MV Tropic Bird* and observe these amazing mammals, once on the brink of extinction, within their natural environment*. During the day, if time permits you may also have the chance to snorkel the crystal clear waters and take part in the spectacular underwater world that surrounds you!

Swim with Whales Option

For those that would like the opportunity to swim with the whales we will endeavour to find humpback whales who are willing to allow us to join them in the clear waters of Vava'u.
